Subject: Visa Exemption.

**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN**

This is to certify that the Turkish passports with the inscription "OFFICIAL/DIPLOMATIC/SPECIAL/SERVICE" are given to those persons who possess an official identity and are equivalent to the "OFFICIAL/DIPLOMATIC" passports issued by the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh.

Pursuant to the disposition of the "Visa Exemption Agreement" signed on 12 November 1987 between the Governments of the People's Republic of Bangladesh and the Republic of Turkey, Turkish Citizens who are holders of "OFFICIAL/DIPLOMATIC/SPECIAL/SERVICE" passports are entitled to enter Bangladesh, and stay for a period of upto three months, without any visa.

The concerned authorities of Bangladesh are, therefore, requested to allow entry of such Turkish Citizens into Bangladesh without stamping "on-arrival-visa" on their passports.
