According to the Article 42, paragraph 8 and Article 50, paragraph 5 of the Law on Seized Property Restitution and Compensation (Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia, No. 72/11), Minister of finance issues a

REGULATION

on application/request form for seized property restitution/compensation, procedure on receipt and processing of the application, list of post offices where requests will be submitted and type and content of the excerpt from application

Article 1

This Regulation, in order to implement the Law on Seized Property Restitution and Compensation (Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia, No. 72/11), provides form of the request for seized property restitution/compensation (hereinafter the 'request'), procedure on request receipt and processing, list of post offices for request submitting and type and content of the excerpt from the request.

Article 2

The request is to be submitted to the Agency for Restitution – its competent territorial unite *(nadležna područna jedinica) by fulfilling `ZVIO` request form for seized property restitution/compensation, which is printed together with this Regulation and is an integral part of it. (Attachment 1)

Article 3

Request is to be submitted at the post offices' counters, list of which is printed together with this Regulation and is an integral part of it. (Attachment 2)

Article 4

Public company PTT Traffic 'Serbia' - Post Office will form special counter for receipt of the requests at the post offices cited at the list mention in the Article 3 of this Regulation.

Request submitted at the post office counter is consider to be submitted at the Agency for Restitution (hereinafter the 'Agency').

Post will issue a receipt confirmation of the request.

If request form does not consist all of the necessary data, or if all of the necessary proof document from the Article 42/7 of the Law are not enclosed, authorized post office clerk trained for the receipt of requests, will inform the applicant which data shall be written into the request or which proof documents shall also be enclosed with the request.

If the request does not contain all of the necessary data, or if all of the necessary document are not enclosed, in accordance with the paragraph 4 of this Article, and the applicant still wishes to submit the request, this will be marked at the receipt confirmation of the request.

In accordance with Article 44 of the Law, the Post will deliver the request together with enclosed document to the Agency's competent territorial unite.

Article 5

Agency maintains records of requests according to the Article 50 of the Law. Once a month, Agency will publish excerpts from the requests on its web-site.

Article 6

Form and contain of the excerpt from the Article 50/4 of the Law are given at the Attachment 3, which is printed together with this Regulation and is an integral part of it.

Article 7

This Regulation will enter into force on the eight day after having been published in Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia.
